A workshop on “*Lecture Plan Pattern for Teacher Educators*” was successfully organized on 13th April 2026 at Teachers' Training College, Bhagalpur (TTCB). The program aimed to enhance the teaching competencies of teacher educators by providing them with a clear understanding of effective lecture planning.

The workshop was conducted by **Dr. Rakesh Kumar**, Former Dean, Faculty of Education, TMBU, and currently serving as an Industry Expert at Aakash, New Delhi. He acted as the resource person and shared his valuable insights with the participants.

During the session, Dr. Rakesh Kumar explained the *Lecture Plan Pattern* in a systematic manner with relevant examples. He elaborated on each component, including the introduction of the chapter (theme, importance, and relation to previous knowledge), development of the topic through clear definitions and explanations, and the use of illustrations, diagrams, and flowcharts for better understanding.

He further demonstrated how to present content effectively by including suitable examples, exceptions, and comparative analysis. The importance of the application stage—where questions are asked to assess students' understanding—was also highlighted. He concluded by explaining how to summarize the topic and emphasize its significance for better retention.

The session was highly interactive, and participants actively engaged in discussions and clarified their doubts. The workshop helped them understand how to design structured, clear, and effective lecture plans.
